

The Blossburg Memorial Library Code of Conduct

This Code of Conduct has been adopted to ensure the safety, comfort, and access to Library resources and facilities for everyone. Library users are responsible for informing themselves of library policies. The following activities are deemed unacceptable and are not permitted in the library:

- Disorderly or disruptive conduct
- Obscene, profane or abusive language or acts
- Possession or use of alcohol or illegal drugs
- Intoxication or impairment
- Mutilation, defacement, or theft of library property
- Harassing or threatening others
- Smoking in all areas of the library
- Failure to evacuate in an emergency or during a drill
- Animals, except service animals, are prohibited
- Possession of deadly weapons of any sort, except by law enforcement officers
- Patrons without shirt or shoes are prohibited
- Conducting inappropriate public displays of affection

Children in the Library

An adult or guardian must accompany children under the age of ten at all times while in the Library. Minors under the age of ten that are left unattended at the Library could be considered a case of child abandonment, and the proper authorities may be contacted.

Public Announcements

Announcements, flyers, personal invitations, etc. need to have prior approval by a staff member before posting in or on Library property.

Cell Phones

Use of cell phones in the Library is disruptive to other library patrons. Cell phones and pagers should be turned off or put on silent mode before entering the Library. Patrons that need to use their cell phones are asked to step outside.

Food and Drink

Food and beverages are permitted. Drinks should be covered at all times. Please do not eat or drink while using the computers or other electronic equipment. Users will be responsible for any damages caused by food or drinks.

*Persons who violate the Blossburg Memorial Library Code of Conduct will be asked to leave the Library. Persons who continually violate Library policies will be referred to the Library Board of Trustees. Disciplinary action will be handled on a case-by-case basis.
